- Revision Sessions
- Academic Clinics
- Stretch and Challenge

Although these can be open to pupils of all ages, the majority of pupils that use these opportunities are Year 11 and Year 13 pupils, our exam classes. To get the best from these opportunities, it is important that we recognise what is expected of our Year 11 and 13 pupils and what we are offering as support.

Revision, some tough truths

- The pupils will have to do it, not the teachers or parents
- Revision sessions may be provided as addition to independent revision, these will not be an adequate substitute to independent revision
- Revision is not about owning the revision guides or flipping through websites. It's tough and involves decisions and willpower

Support

We all want the best for our AKS students and have tried to develop our Curriculum Plus Programme to be as helpful as possible. Throughout what we offer you will see Revision Session or Academic Clinic regularly labelled. There are differences to each of the sessions and each department and staff member offer what they feel is most appropriate for the pupils they teach. The difference between the two is highlighted below.

- Revision Sessions: these are led and planned by the teachers, perhaps taking pupils through certain topics or skills they may need to know.
- Academic Clinic: pupils direct the content of the session. Pupils are expected to come to
 clinic sessions with questions on specific topics they don't understand, perhaps by 'postit' noting their exercise book, textbook or revision guide. This way targeted help can be
 provided by teachers.

Learning Support continues to provide Year 11 and A level monitoring and support sessions with some sessions before school, during lunchtimes or via email, depending on the preference of the student. They advise on the revision strategies and the most effective use of the individual access arrangements.
