Between 2017-22, the care leaver progression rate into university increased from 12.64% to 14.18%. The progression rate of noncare leavers into higher education in 2022 was 47%.

Key Information:

- Its higher education sector comprises 89 Spanish universities, out of which 50 are public, and 39 are private universities (listed in this article), which includes some of the best business schools.
- Statistics indicate that over the span of 7 years, the number of international students in Spanish universities has risen by roughly 46% from the academic year 2015/2016 to 2021/2022.
- For entry onto a course, you'll usually need a secondary education leaving certificate. Some universities may also require you to sit and pass an entrance exam. The majority of university courses are taught in Spanish, so you'll need to prove your proficiency.
