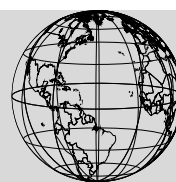

Key Information:

- There are five different types of institutions that offer degree programmes in Austria.
- The country has a similar population to London with 50 times the space.
- Learning some German, the official language of Austria, is highly advisable.
- Tuition fees for students outside of the European Union (EU) are €726.72 (£624.47) per semester. On top of that, there is a compulsory student union membership fee and accident insurance fee of €20.20 (£17.36) per semester. Private universities typically set their own fees, as do teacher education colleges. Be sure to research your chosen institution for specific details.
